

WINCHESTER MYSTERY HOUSE ANNOUNCES THE RETURN OF ITS ANNUAL MOTHER'S DAY BRUNCH

SAN JOSE (April 22, 2019) – **Winchester Mystery House** announced today that its annual Mother's Day Brunch will return on **Sunday, May 12 at 11 a.m.** Tickets (\$99 for adults and \$19 for children ages 4–12) include brunch, bottomless mimosas for guests ages 21+, and a tour of the mansion and are available online now at winchestermysteryhouse.com/buy-tickets/. Admission for children three and under is free.

The brunch will take place on the estate's beautiful Victorian Gardens, a picturesque setting filled with Cherry Laurels, boxwood hedges, hundreds of flowers, and mythological statues. The menu features assorted breakfast pastries, fresh seasonal fruit, a baby potato medley hash with wild arugula, a roasted asparagus, leek and goat cheese frittata, a waffle bar, and more. After brunch, guests will enjoy the 65-minute **Mansion Tour**, which provides access to 110 of the 160 rooms of Sarah Winchester's stately home, as well as an in-depth guide to the bizarre attributes that give the mansion its name.

About Winchester Mystery House

For nearly 100 years the Winchester Mystery House in San Jose, California, has stood as a testament to the ingenuity, singular vision and lore that surrounds its namesake, Sarah Pardee Winchester (heiress to the Winchester Repeating Arms fortune). Originally known as Llanada Villa, today it stands as an architectural wonder, a time capsule of a bygone era and one of America's most celebrated haunted mansions. The estate is listed on the National Register of Historic Places, is a California Historic State Landmark, a San Jose City Landmark, and is one of the leading attractions in the Bay Area. Since tours began in 1923, more than 13 million people from around the world have toured the lonely hallways, dark passages and ornate rooms of the Winchester Mystery House. It has intrigued visitors, scholars, and media from throughout the United States, and around the globe, with its combination of the beautiful and the bizarre, its story of heartbreak, tenacity and invention and its legends of the paranormal.
